

## **Incoming 4th Grade - Summer Math Fact Practice:**

It is extremely important for each incoming 4th grader to know their math facts in order to not feel overwhelmed with our 4th grade math curriculum. We cover a lot of material and it will be difficult for the students who do not know their basic math facts. Therefore, we are asking that incoming fourth graders practice all of their math facts over the summer, 2s through 12s, so they are in great shape for the beginning of this school year. This will start the week of July 7th and go through the week of August 25th.

We are asking students to do Math Fact practice for a minimum of 15 minutes per day. Your children can use flashcards, worksheets, or math computer programs such as Reflex to practice. There is a table on the back side of this sheet where they will log in the number of minutes they spend each day of each week. Please include a parent signature at the end of each practice week. At the end of each week, students will take the four minute timed test (attached) and see how they improve each week! Have them bring these 4 minute timed tests back with them to school on the first day. The 4 minute tests have 100 problems on each side for both division and multiplication. (4 minutes per side!)
